Mike, Bryan, Dave, Omery, and Keene were excited when the audit results came in - we had achieved an OS1 Green Program of Merit! The OS1 Audit contains approximately 627 key factors that are predicators of success in a cleaning operation. Green Programs

of Merit are achieved when the janitorial team scores correctly 80% or above. Mike, Bryan, Dave, Omery, and Keene had been audited in three buildings at the USCG Base - Command, Medical Clinic, and Sector. The auditors spent roughly 10 hours examine the custodial operations from an administrative standpoint to the on-site inspection that includes interviews of each custodial team member. Thinking back on the day of the audit, the team was nervous but they were ready. The monthly trainings and on-site reviews with Guido that take place organically throughout the year at all locations enables any team to get ready to undergo the scrutiny of the auditors.

Being so proud of the team, we wanted to do something a little unique and special to commemorate this achievement! Therefore we created a plaque for each command at the USCG Base LA/LB and presented it to the Commanding Officer and their staff.
